## Addressing Standards:

- 1. Your private Road must be named and signed with a county issued sign if the road has two or more residences or is more than a half mile long.
- 2. Residents must display their issued number per county standards. A copy of these standards will be given to you once your number has been issued.
- 3. The postal service will eventually use the physical address as the mailing address. To avoid confusion; the project may require the changing of some road names.
- 4. Numbers will be assigned every 5.28 feet. This will allow for 1000 numbers per mile. The number assigned gives meaning to an address. For example; 3746 Smith Town Rd is located approximately 3.75 miles from the beginning of Smith Town Rd.


