Request for Proposals for Dilapidated Structures Consulting Engineer

The Summers County Commission is requesting proposals for the position of Consulting Engineer until January 13, 2022 at 4:30 PM. The Summers County Commission is seeking persons or firms qualified to assist with the enforcement of the Summers County Dilapidated Structures Ordinance enacted in 2012. The duties of the Consulting Engineer include, but are not limited to, inspecting and documenting identified properties, performing title research for the identified properties, attending committee meetings, coordinating remediation or teardown logistics, and making recommendations regarding current and future properties that meet the ordinance criteria, and other duties as assigned by the Summers County Commission. The qualified person or firm should have a basic knowledge of engineering principles, county geography, infrastructure, and the Summers County, West Virginia Dilapidated Structures Ordinance. Compensation shall be by hourly rate and is negotiable.
